The company that is well known as the most versatile glass wholesaler in all of Europe sees opportunities in the field of laminated glass and is currently in the process of establishing their own fully automated laminating factory.

They selected a Benteler laminating line and a Scholz autoclave. The line can produce laminated glass up to 2550x6000mm. With 27 PVB rolls, of which 10 can be switched automatically, this laminating line is one of the fastest there is. By selecting both the Benteler line and a Scholz autoclave, GSWB consciously chooses for quality and invests in the future.

With this investment of more than 2 million Euro GSWB will soon have an in-house production capacity available of 60 tonnes or 3 full trucks of laminated glass per day. This laminating line will be located in a new factory hall of more than 2,500m2, next to the existing 11,000m2. This new laminating factory will allow GSWB to further expand its range - which is already the most extensive in Europe - and service considerably. They also have a fleet of 20 trucks at their disposal to facilitate distribution in the Benelux and further into Europe.

Laminating options are thereby increasing enormously, including safety glass, soundproof glass, solar control glass, burglar resistant glass, coloured glass, bullet resistant glass and much more under the new name: Cura-Glass®

If everything goes according to plan the new factory will be completed in early June. The machines should then be installed in mid-July and the production of laminated glass should start at the beginning of November.
